In compliance with the Notification of the University Grants Commission, F.No.14-4/2012(CPP-II), dated New Delhi, the ___ December, 2012, the Governing Body of Model Christian College is honoured to constitute the Grievance Redressal Committee of Model Christian College.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The Aims and Objectives of the Grievance Redressal Committee are:

- To address the grievances of students;
- To assess publication of prospectus, its contents and pricing;
- To bring admission and disciplinary action under grievance redressal mechanism.

COMPOSITION

The Grievance Redressal Committee shall consist of:

- Managing Director of the College Chairperson,
- Administrator Member,
- Principal Member,
- Vice Principal Member,
- Academic Dean Member,
- Dean of Students' Welfare Member Secretary,

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be on ex-officio basis.

TENURE

The Grievance Redressal Committee shall be a permanent body.

QUORUM

One-half of the total membership shall constitute the quorum.

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS

The Grievance Redressal Committee:

- Shall inform students about the procedure in redressal of grievances;
- 2. Shall hear and decide any grievance of any student in relation to admission, false information in the prospectus, withhold or refusal to return any document, fees, provision

of amenities, discrimination, denial of quality education, non transparent or unfair evaluation practices, harassment and victimisation;

- Shall not entertain any application for revaluation or remarking of answer sheets.
- 4. Shall ensure the prospectus contains-
 - a) Each component of the fee, deposits and other charges payable by the students admitted to the institution, and other terms and conditions of such payment;
 - Percentage of fee and charges refundable to students who withdraw from the institution before or after completion of study;
 - The number of seats approved by the Nagaland University;
 - d) Conditions for eligibility for admission in a particular course;
 - e) Process of admission and selection of eligible candidates;
 - f) Details of teaching faculty qualification, year of experience, regular or visiting;
 - g) Information in regard to physical and academic infrastructure and other facilities;
 - All relevant instructions in regard to maintaining discipline by students within or outside the campus, especially prohibition of ragging of any student;
 - All the above information are posted on the College website and advertisements in newspapers or other media.

PROCEDURE OF REDRESSAL OF GRIEVANCES

- Application for redressal of grievances shall be submitted in writing either personally to the Dean of Students' Welfare or drop in the Suggestion Box.
- On receipt of any application, the Dean of Students' Welfare shall inform the Grievance Redressal Committee.
- The Grievance Redressal Committee shall fix a date for hearing the complaint and communicate the same to the aggrieved person.
- An aggrieved person may appear in person to present his/her case.
- The Grievance Redressal Committee shall be guided by the principles of natural justice while hearing the grievance.
- The Grievance Redressal Committee shall ensure disposal of every application as speedily as possible and not later than a month of receipt of the grievance.
- 7. On the conclusion of proceedings, the Grievance Redressal Committee shall pass such order, with reasons for such order, as may be deemed fit to redress the grievance and provide such relief as may be desirable to the affected party at issue.
- Every order shall be provided to the aggrieved person and shall be placed on the website of the institution.
- In case of any false or frivolous complaint, the Grievance Redressal Committee shall order appropriate action against the complainant.
