ARTICLE - 13: POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVES:

- 1. President:
 - i. The President shall be the Head of the Executive Council.
 - He/She is empowered to advise and instruct any of the Executives. ii.
 - iii. He/She shall preside over the meetings of the Executive Council and the General Body.
 - He/She, after referring the matter to the Executive Council, is empowered to iv. accept/reject the resignation of any Office Bearer.
 - He/She is empowered to act on behalf of the MCCSC.
 - His/Her consent has to be taken into account in planning, working and vi. organizing any activity.
 - The President exercises the above (i) to (vi) powers with the consent and vii. approval of the Executive Council.

2. Vice President:

- The Vice- President shall assist the President in all official matters of the i. Executive Council.
- He/She is empowered to act and exercise all the powers of the President in his/her absence or, in case of Resignation/Removal of the President, till the new President is elected.
- 3. General Secretary:
 - The General Secretary, in consultation with the President, shall convene the 1. meetings of the Executive Council, and record the meeting minutes and other correspondences.
 - In the absence of the President and Vice- President, the General Secretary shall assume the responsibilities and functions of the President/Vice-President.

4. Joint Secretary

- The Joint Secretary shall assist the General Secretary i.
- He/She shall perform the duties of the General Secretary in his/her absence.
- 5. Treasurer:6
 - i. The Treasurer shall keep the fund of the Council.
 - ii. He/She shall maintain record of receipt and expenditure.
- 6. Games & Sports Secretary:
 - The Games & Sports Secretary shall be responsible for organizing the Sports Week and other sports related activities.
 - He/She shall maintain and record all the sports goods and activities.
- 7. Joint Games & Sports Secretary:
 - i. He /She shall assist the Games & Sports Secretary in any Sports activity.
 - He/She shall perform the duties of Games & Sports Secretary in his/her absence.
- Women Co-ordinator:
 - There shall be one Women Co-ordinator to look after the welfare of the i. women folk in the college.
 - She shall be responsible for promoting the various activities of women
- 9. Cultural Secretary:
 - He/She shall be responsible for organizing cultural activities in the college.7 i.
- 10. Literary Secretary:

He/She shall be responsible for organizing any literary activities in the college.

11. Information and Publicity Secretary:

He/She shall be responsible for giving information, press release and advertisement.

ARTICLE - 14: GENERAL BODY MEETING8

- The Student Council shall convene General Meeting at least twice in a tenure, i.e., one at the beginning of the tenure and the other at the end of the tenure.
- The President shall have the power to convene special General Meetings, if required, in consultation with the Dean of Students Welfare (DSW).
