MCC conducts workshop on innovative teaching

DIMAPUR: Model Christian College (MCC) conducted a two day workshop on innovative teaching on July 12 and 13 with NEHU, department of education, assistant professor, Dr. Euodia Bahun Myrthong, and St. Mary's College of Teacher Education, Shillong, senior lecturer Calmy R. Kharlukhi, as resource persons.

A press release by MCC administrator Albert Ariicho said the two day workshop was organized by the departments of Education and English, and sponsored by the Indian Council of Social Science Research, North Eastern Regional Centre, NEHU Campus, Shillong.

Calmy emphasized on the different strategies of teaching involving technology. She also spoke about the constructivist method where students construct their unique understanding of a subject based on their past experiences with teachers as facilitators.

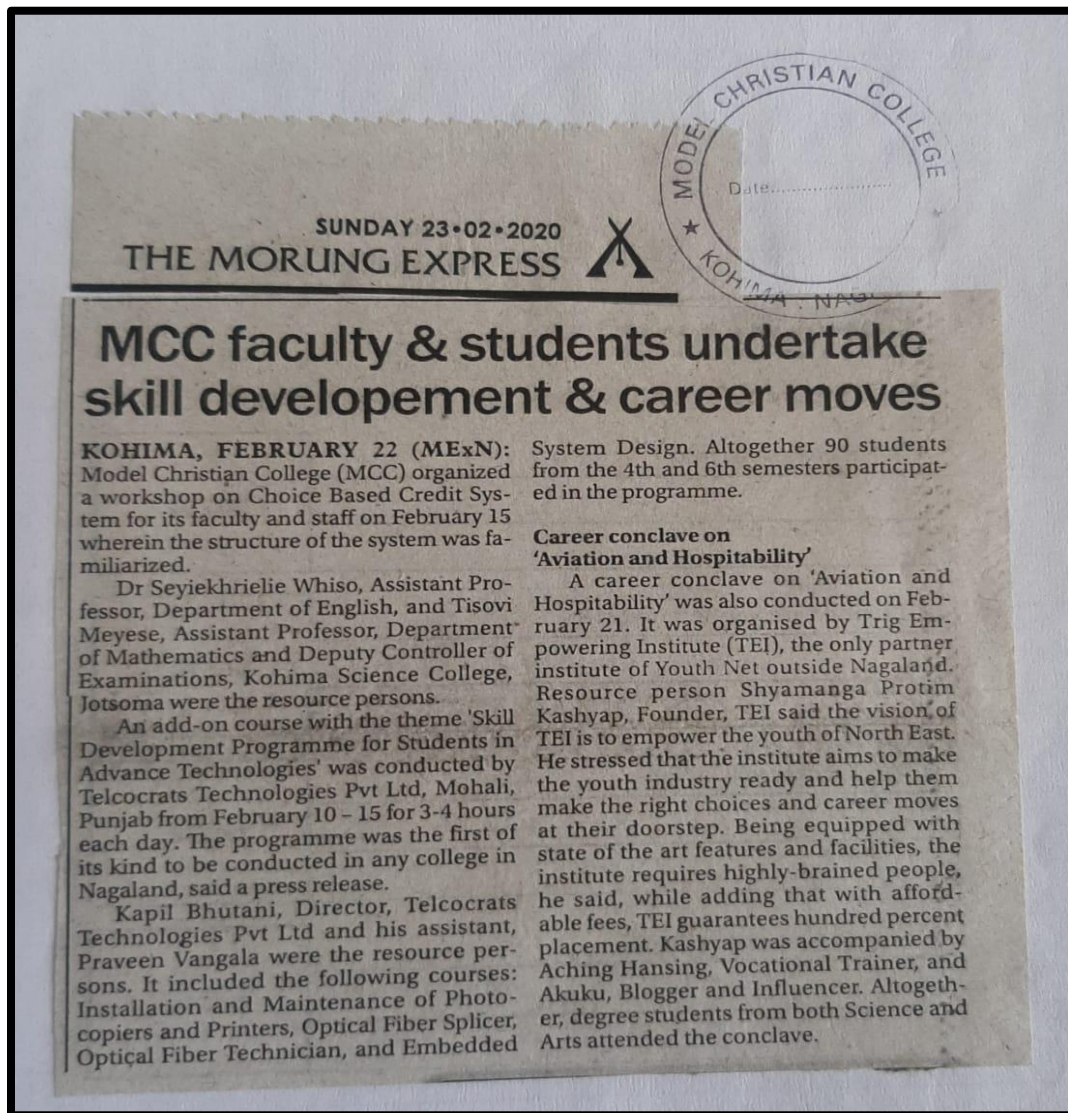
