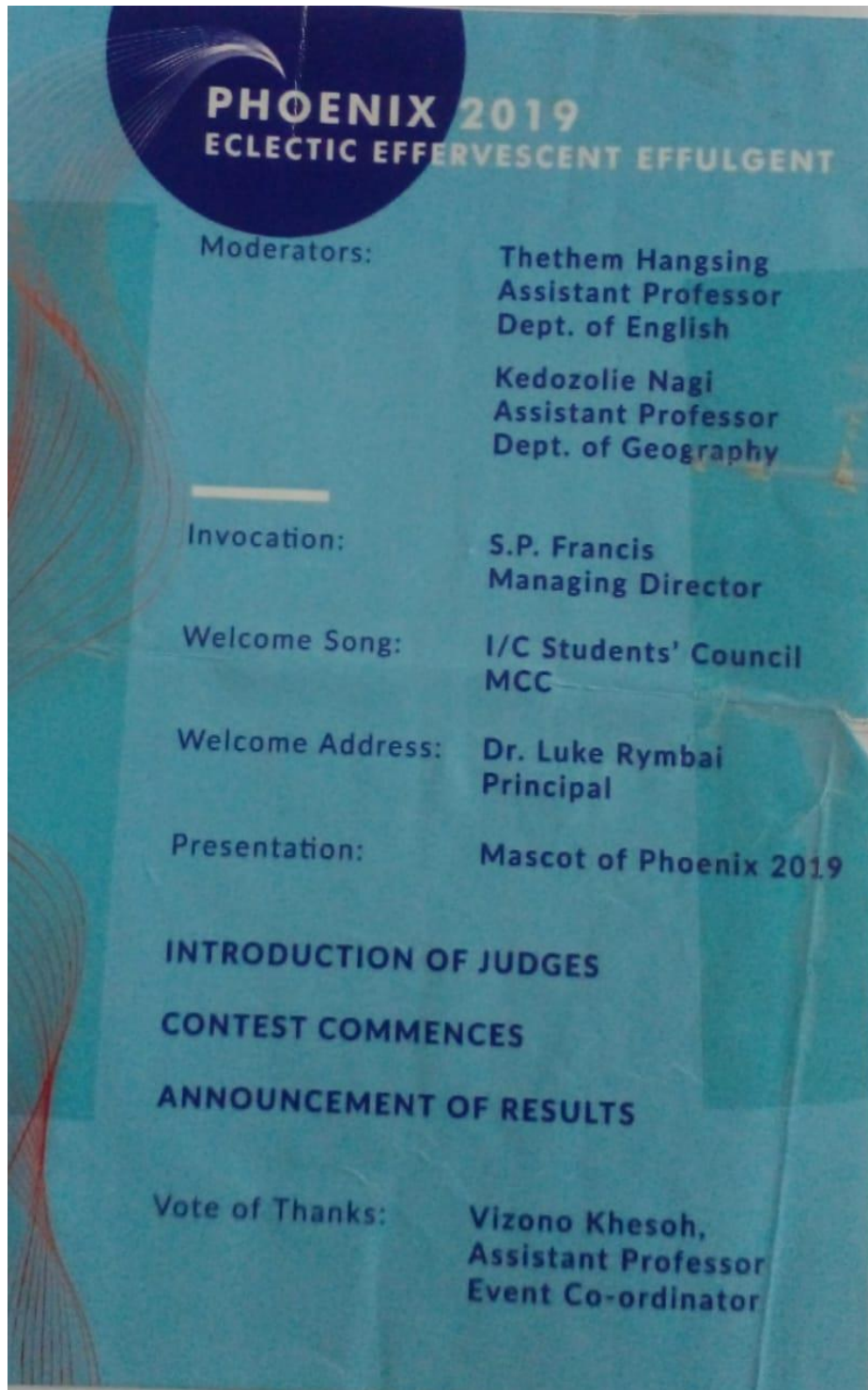
2. Phoenix.



Report of Phoenix

Model Christian College organized the first inter-collegiate talent hunt 'Phoenix' under the theme 'Education, Empowerment, Enrichment' on the 30th of August 2019. Altogether 14 colleges participated and the judges were Dr. Kilembunga, Ms. Mele Pukro and Mrs. Manje Soukhrie. Before the competition commenced, Bendangtoshi (B.Sc 3rd Semester) performed the March Phoenix 2019 walk. Special items before the results were presented by Zenlie Laputoni (B.Sc 3rd Semester), Bendangshiep (B.Sc 5th Semester) and Machogin (B.Sc 3rd Semester).

The 1st Prize was bagged by Ancherle Walling of Modern Pine (₹ 15,000), 2nd Prize by Phyanawo doha of Kues College (₹ 10,000) and the 3rd Prize by Heudalon of Baptist College (₹ 5000). The consolation prizes of ₹ 1000 each were given to St. Joseph's College, Japen College, Sangli College, Model Christian College and Don Bosco College respectively.

The 3rd Prize money of the talent hunt was sponsored by the coordinator of Women Cell (MCC) Madam Jamkhamoi Tombing. Model Christian College organizes 'Phoenix 2019'
