MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is made at MODEL CHRISTIAN COLLEGE, on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of July (hereafter referred to as "MOU") by and between Nagaland State AIDS Control Society (hereafter referred to as "NSACS") MODEL CHRISTIAN COLLEGE having its College at KOCHIMA District, Naga (thereafter referred to as "the college"). Whereas, Red Ribbon Club has been formed in the college on 2010 college shall continue to carry out RRC activities according to the following guidelines of National AIDS Control Organisation as under:

ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES:

While the Institution may be persuaded to support RRC activities financially and introduce RRC and its events into permanent entities and event calendar of the institution. The major roles of the College will include:

- Designate the Faculty teacher or NSS Coordinator as Nodal Officer/ Programme Officer for RRC.
- Mainstreaming of HIV/AIDS programme by including it in the University curriculum & programme.
- Advocacy at the highest level to support the programme on self sustainable basis.
- Encouraging the contribution of RRC members by highlighting it in college newsletter or other publications.
- In order to make RRC Programme effective and to spread awareness, activities will be conducted in the form Awareness Campaign within and outside the College Campus in the form Blood Donation Camps, Seminars on HIV/AIDS, Programs on debate competition, essay competition, painting competition, Poster Competition, Story Competition; Exposure visit to the Service Centres; and other youth related activities on HIV & AIDS.
- For effective constitution and functioning of RRC, it is proposed to constitute a Committee. The Committee shall include:

1. **Chairperson:** Principal/Head of the institute.
2. **Convener:** Nodal Officer (N.O) / Nodal Officer/ Programme Officer.
3. **Star Members:** A students holding positions of President, Vice-President, General Secretary, and Assistant Secretary as **Star Members** of the RRC with other RRC members also acting as an active part of the forum structure. The selected students should act as Peer-Educators.

4. The Advisory Committee should meet to review the activities of the RRC and plan future activity as per the annual activity plan and also review and approve new activities proposed by the RRC members.
